Indian shoots at an alleged UFO, receives an electrical discharge and falls unconscious in the village of Feijó

Last week, an Indian known as Iaka Kampa, who lives in the Nova Floresta village, on the Envira River, in the municipality of Feijó, was hit by an Unidentified Flying Object (UFO) discharge. The alleged "flying saucer" would have been seen by other Indians, who fire 18 shots in its path. "It was very fast, it had a very strong and greenish light", said the Indian Airton Kampa.

Also according to Kampa, the Indians thought it was a drone, but because it burned the beaks of all the lanterns and emitted strong electrical discharges, they were terrified. "He always showed up at 1:30 in the morning and stayed more or even until two o'clock," said the Indian, who brought his injured friend to the city's hospital.

The retired professor at the Federal University of Acre (UFAC), Carvalho de Melo, would also have seen a UFO with the same characteristics, this time on the margins of BR 364, in the direction of Manoel Urbano-Feijó. The report has not yet made contact with the professor, who also lives in Feijó.
